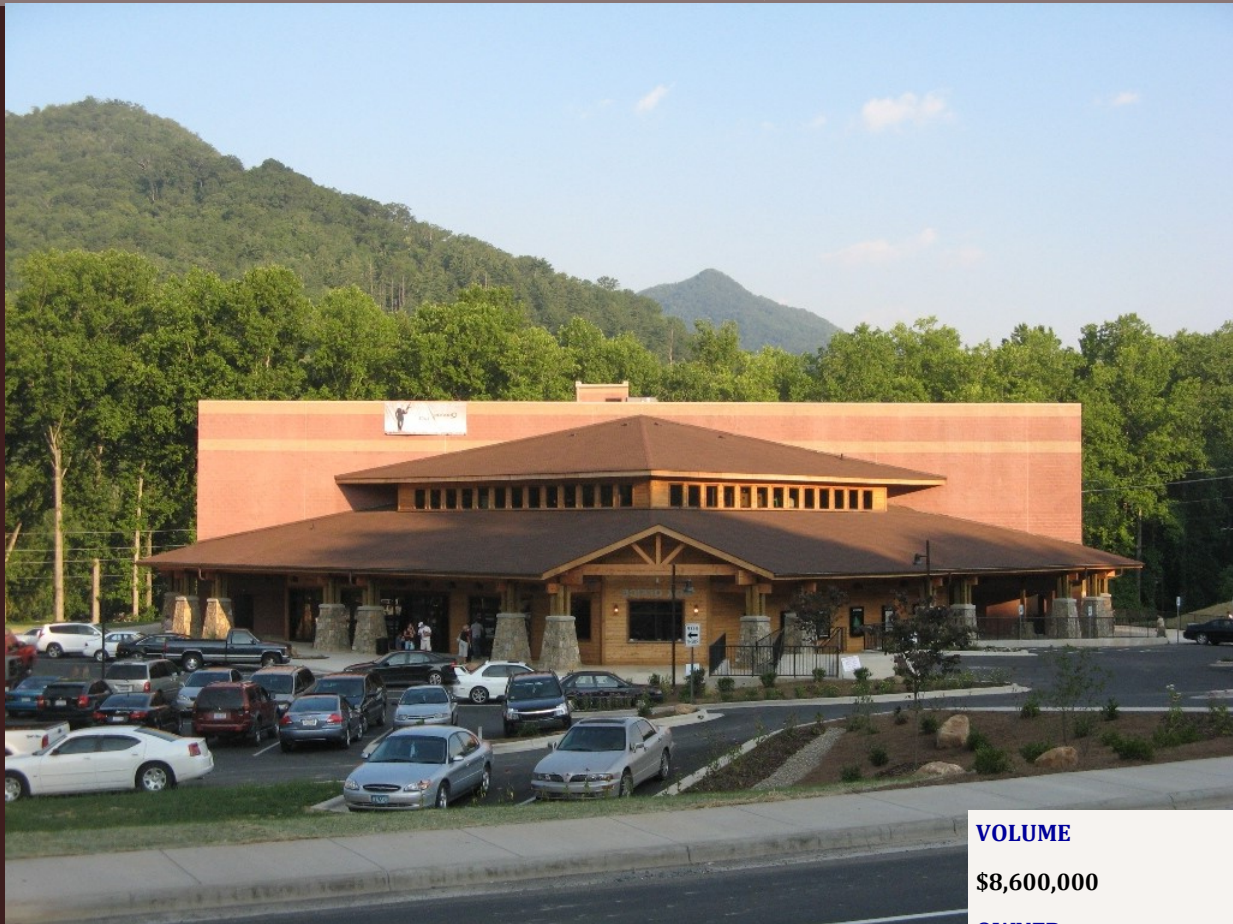


PHOENIX THEATER

CHEROKEE PHOENIX THEATER

The Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, in an effort to attract movie goers and offer additional recreational opportunities for the surrounding area, constructed a 6 screen theater. This project, completed over 2 contracts with Owle Construction LLC, first offered 2 theaters in the summer of 2008, and added 4 theaters in the fall of 2013. For the design, the EBCI first hired Acanthus Engineering of Asheville, NC and, for the 2nd phase, utilized Rodney Sartain of Homewood, Alabama. These theaters offer the movie-goer the highest technology within the movie viewing industry— including surround sound; 3D movies; and raised, reclined theater seating. Additionally, the theater offers a gaming area on the 2nd floor and a party room on the 1st floor.
