Renovation of existing recreational space



CHEROKEE OUTDOOR THEATER

Owle Construction LLC, in a 2-phase construction project, renovated the existing recreational space of the Unto These Hills Outdoor Theater. Each phase was designed by Proctor-Hodge of Cherokee, NC, and constructed during the winter and spring months of the year. Construction consisted of replacing the existing rain shelter with glulam timber framing- representing "trees," -and a tongue and groove wood ceiling; installing steel grass rail; renovating the existing bathrooms; sound booth; and concession area; upgrading existing concrete walk areas ; and replacing existing outdoor seating. Additionally, an eternal flame was constructed to capture the history of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians and offer a dedication focal point for the newly constructed Theater.
